

1. Place a large drain pan under the oil pan.



- 2. Remove the transmission oil drain screw and drain fluid.
- 3. Tighten drain screw. Torque: 38 Nm (28 ft. lbs.) .
- 4. Remove the transmission overfill screw and fill transmission through overfill screw opening, using DEXRON-III ATF.
- 5. Let engine idle until a fluid temperature between 32°C (90°F) and57°C (135°F) is reached.
- Add transmission fluid until it flows out over the overfill screw opening, then close the overfill screw. Torque: 38 Nm (28 ft. lbs.). NOTE: Transmission fluid temperature to be check with service tool. See: Powertrain Management\Transmission Control Systems\Testing and Inspection
